SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

- Personnel Update
  - New Hire - Holley-Bright (3rd grade reading)
  - Temporary Hire - Scrivens (high school histor / ACT English)
  - E. Varnado moved, L. McRae seconded to ratify the new hires. Approved.
- Professional Development
  - 20 teachers and administrators visited Henderson Collegiate charter school, one of the most successful Title 1 charter schools in the state, for a workshop on last Saturday.
- Student Achievement
  - We are shooting for a “B” on our report card--will need about 65%proficiency with growth.
  - Dr. Johnson shared other benchmark data relating to Read-to-Achieve and EOG proficiency benchmarks.
  - We have started Saturday school.
  - Our high school chorus will be singing at Elon University, and will also sing along with Spelman College chorus and the Elon University chorus in a second performance at Elon.
- Dr. Johnson discussed her difficulty in obtaining student records from Guilford County Schools—of particular concern is her inability to receive the records of exceptional children. She has written a letter to the Superintendent of Guilford County Schools for 23 student files that still have not been received. She has copied the Office of Charter Schools and the Director of EC at NCDPI.
- Regarding our EC audit, Dr. Johnson received an email indicating that we are in compliance. Copies of the email sent to the Office of Charter School, et. al..
